About Scottsdale Artists' School:

Workshop hours are 9:00 am to 4:00 pm unless otherwise noted. School Office hours are 8:30am to 5:00pm.

The studio you will be using is yours for the week so materials may be left in the studio overnight.

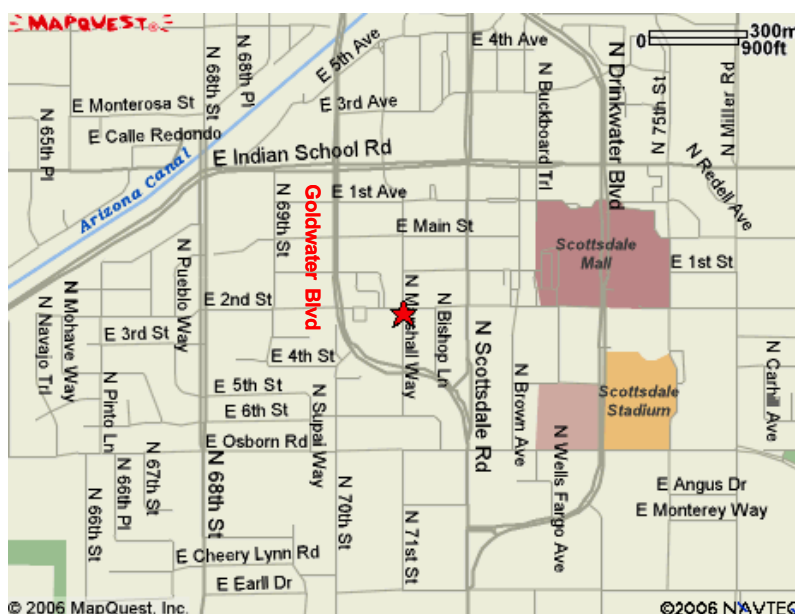
The School store features books and some DVD's written by or featuring some of the School's instructors along with a small selection of art supplies.

Studio Policies and Etiquette:

- Remember to turn off your cell phone! Please take phone calls outside.
- You **MUST** get permission from the model to photograph him/her. Tipping is customary.
- Photography with a nude model present is strictly prohibited (demos included)
- Video cameras are not permitted in the studios.
- Odorless mineral spirits or odorless turpenoid are permitted. Please no turpentine.
- According to Arizona State Law, no smoking is allowed in public buildings or within 20 feet of any building entrance.

The City of Scottsdale offers a **free trolley service** that runs through the historic downtown area and up to the Fashion Square from 11 am until 9pm everyday. A trolley stop is located across the street from the School at the Transit Station.

Getting Here: The School suggests students fly into Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport located about 20 minutes from the School. The School is located in the center of downtown Scottsdale which is surrounded by a variety of hotels and restaurants. The city of Scottsdale is very walkable and if students are comfortable walking, a rental car is now necessary. Open Studio / No Instructor

Practice your skills on your own during Open Studio. The School provides a model and equipment. Participants bring their own supplies to draw, paint or sculpt. Registration is not required; however space is limited to the first 16 participants. **Students currently enrolled in a workshop may attend the 3-hour Open Studio sessions for FREE during the week of their workshop.**

Air Travel: Please call your airline if you have questions regarding art supplies in carry on or checked luggage.

Shipping: Students are welcome to ship art supplies to the School, however, supplies may only arrive one week prior to your workshop. Packages must be clearly labeled with your name and the instructors name and class date.
