Painting Fundamentals: Exploring Color

Oil Paint: Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Orange, Cadmium Yellow, Ultramarine Blue and Titanium White. (Student grade paint is far less expensive for the beginning painter. “Winton” colors by Windsor and Newton as example)

Brushes: about a half dozen medium to small sized bristle brushes. There are several brush shapes. I prefer long “flats” or “filberts”. Also suggested... one or two small synthetic “rounds”.

Odorless paint thinner (I prefer Gamsol)

Brush washing bucket (I prefer the air tight aluminum versions)

Generous sized “palette “to mix paint on

Paper towels

Several 8” x 10” cotton canvas panel boards for each class
