

## **John Hughes Supply List**

There are certain paints that I recommend. They are all Utrecht colors, but any of your favorite brands will work. Quinacradone Rose may be substituted with Permanent Alizarin Crimson.

### **Oil Colors:**

Cerulean Blue Hue

Ultramarine Blue

Quinacridone Rose

Cadmium Orange

Cadmium Yellow Lemon Pure

Cadmium Yellow Medium

### **Medium:**

Two small squeeze bottles:

- 1- Linseed oil and Odorless mineral spirits 50/50 mixture.
- 2- Galkyd Lite, by Gamblin

**A Metal Brush-washer** (with a lid!)

### **Odorless Mineral Spirits**

**Tissues of Paper Towels** (I use tissues and attach them right to my tripod)

**Bristle Brushes,** (Flats and Filberts of various sizes - #s 2, 4 and 6 are very useful) plus a small bunny or soft fan brush with a liner brush.

Palette Knives (Small, Medium and Large) The large one is a palette scraper; the other two diamond shapes are for painting.

**Easel and palette of your choice.** (I use various ones, mostly the Open Box M. Just make sure you can secure your painting tightly to your rig in case of wind.)

**Trash bags**

**Hat with a brim**

**Dress for changing weather**

**Camera or cell phone**

**Small sketch pad**

**View finder**
