## **Supply List** The Joy of Painting - Abstract Realism

**PAINT**: You may bring whatever colors you feel comfortable with but please bring heavy body acrylics. I typically use artists grade Liquitex and Golden but I use other brands, as well. These are the colors I like to use (I prefer cadmium free but use the other, too):

Titanium White Cadmium Yellow Medium Yellow Oxide Cadmium Orange Cadmium Red Light Napthol Crimson Ultra Marine Blue(green shade) Burnt Sienna Dioxazine Purple Pthalo Green (blue shade) Medium Magenta Sap Green Yellow Green Permanent Green Light Green Gold Any turquoise or teal color

### **PALETTE**:

- Masterson Sta-Wet palette (12x16). It usually comes with special palette paper and a sponge. If not, you will need to buy those separately.
- Palette Paper or several coated paper plates (for the black gesso)

## **MARKMAKING TOOLS:**

- Palette Knives : Please bring a set of good quality palette knives. I recommend this set (or the like) - RGM 6 Italian Plus. It is a set of 6 in various sizes and is available on Amazon. You may also find knives like these at local art stores.
- Brushes: One size 2 flat or bristle brush and a larger one that measures about 1.5" to 3" wide (could be a gesso brush). We will mostly be using palette knives.
- **<u>Drawing</u>**: 1 pastel pencil and small pencil sharpener (I use light blue)

• Optional Markmaking Tools: Old credit cards, Falling in Art Silicone Paint Brush Set (set of 3 color shapers available on Amazon, or the like)

### **PAINTING SUPPORTS:**

- Strathmore 9x12 Acrylic Paper Pad
- Canvas panels or stretched canvas, your preference. Small to medium sizes, your preference, such as 8x8, 8x16, 9x12, 11x14, 12x12, 12x16, 16x20.

#### **OTHER REQUIRED SUPPLIES:**

- Paper Towels (I like Viva Signature Cloth for better absorption)
- Spray misting bottle for water
- Two containers for water (I use large yogurt containers)
- Plastic bag for garbage
- Sketch book and soft lead pencil (6B or higher)

#### **OPTIONAL SUPPLIES**:

- Apron or paint shirt
- Golden Acrylic Retarder (slows drying time of paint)
- Golden Glazing Liquid (gloss or satin, your preference)
- Airtight paint storage palette box (I don't use these but some people love them!)
- Hand held mirror
- Q Tips
- Reference Photos that can be broken down into 3 to 5 distinct shapes. I will provide some to work from but after we learn the basics, you may choose to use your own.
- Notanizer App (or similar) downloaded on your cell phone or tablet
