### Suggested Supply List:

You can bring whatever colors that you feel comfortable with! These are the colors that I use. (same as my oil paint palette);

#### Winsor & Newton and Holbein:

Permanent White/Titanium White

Cad Yellow

Cad Yellow Lemon

Cad Red Light

Permanent Rose

Van Dyke Brown (good brown)

Sepia (good dark brown)

Chromium Oxide Green

#### Pencil:

Water Soluble Pencil (neutral color)

#### Medium:

WN watercolor Aquapasto (I use this sometimes)

#### Brushes:

I use several different brands; all are synthetic:

Galleria # 1 round, # 2 short/bright Flat, #4 Flat, #12 Flat, # 18 short Flat/bright

Royal Soft Grip # 8, #4, # 10, SG 150, 3/4 SG 700

Simply Simmons # 16 Shader

Winsor & Newton University F # 10, # 12

Creative Mark, # 1.5" Polar Flo, wash-mate

#### Palette:

Plastic Air tight palette, has 24 wells.

Plastic containers that have wells to hold paint in that has a cover

(like bead organizers) or ice cube tray with a cover.

Disposable Gray or White (I use gray) Palette, 12"x 16" (bigger is easier to mix paint)

Painting Surface:

Arches Watercolor Pad, 10"x 14", or other sizes.

Moleskin Watercolor Album, Cold Pressed, Acid Free, 135 lb, 11 ¼ x 8 ¼.

Strathmore Illustration Boards.

Any Watercolor Paper/Pad that is 135 lb.

"Yes" canvas panels - Sizes: 6x6", 8x8", 8x10" or any size you prefer!

For Gouache it is best to stay with smaller size painting surface.

Other Items:

Container for water

Spray/Misting Bottle (very important!)

Painters blue tape (to create borders)

Plastic T-Square 12" (Arizona Art Supply or Jerry's Artarama in Tempe or on line)

Paper Towels (Viva)

Hand Held Mirror

Plastic Bag

iPhone, Tablet, iPad

Bring your favorite photos
