Scottsdale Artists' School is hosting a FREE two day mentorship program with renowned painter Daniel Keys, **January 31-February 2, 2020**. This unique weekend workshop is designed for those who aspire to cultivate their talent and skills into a future art career. A handful of promising students will be selected based on their skills, passion and experience as reflected in an original one-page essay submitted to the artist for review. An orientation will take place Friday evening to kick off the weekend. The workshop will run from 9am-4pm on Saturday and Sunday.

ABOUT THE ARTIST... Daniel J. Keys was born in October 1985, in Fresno, CA. Upon noticing a glimpse of artistic talent in him at an early age, Daniel was encouraged by his parents to pursue his passion, namely painting; and being entirely home educated, time was very permitting for him to develop his skills as a self taught artist. He started painting at the age of 11 using a paint set purchased with birthday money. It was during these formative years that Daniel discovered the work of master artist Richard Schmid, and began emulating Schmid's style in his own paintings. Since that time, Daniel has had the opportunity to paint with his mentor, and Mr. Schmid has become an art adviser to him. Daniel's work is now praised and collected by many prominent art enthusiasts from around the country. He is represented by several major art galleries and continues to teach workshops around the country (including Scottsdale Artists' School).

"If our youth are also our future, then wouldn't we be wise to say that the future of art is in the hands of today's children? That's a question I've recently begun to ask myself, and one that's been ruminating in the minds of some of the greatest living artists today. We must view each opportunity to educate our youth about art as an investment in the future of art itself.

- **1-2 images of your artwork**
